



REBELS LOOK TO BOUNCE BACK IN 2018

brad@mckenziebanner.com s the McKenzie Rebels prepare to begin their 2018 campaign, Head Coach Wade Comer sat down with The Banner to discuss what fans can expect to see on Friday nights this fall.

The team is hoping to get back to postseason form following an upand-down 2017 that ended in disap-

pointment as the 5-5 Rebels narrowly missed the playoffs. Comer said that, as the preseason was nearing a close, "We've got to get a lot better, gotta improve, but I like the attitude of our team. It's starting to come together, and I can see improvement each and every day as far as work ethic goes and a willingness

to be coachable ' He's looking to his upperclassmen for leadership, especially seniors Stephone Haynes and Murphy Watkins and juniors Kyle Maxwell, Nick Baker and Evan Jarrett. "So far, I like what they've done. We've got some growing pains, but that's to be expected." The coach said he's pleased

with the offseason work.

On offense, Comer feels like he has a lot of tools. He expects big things from senior wide receiver Tyler Spivey. He says that junior quarterback Evan Jarrett is "developing nicely." Runningback Joseph Miller is coming off of a big season, and the coach hopes for more of the same. He also expects to get production out of seniors Bryston Diggs and Deshaun Woodson

Asked about how he feels cutting Jarrett loose with the arm in his first year as starter, Comer said, "He's making good decisions with the football, getting it out on time and making the correct reads. Hopefully we'll be able to be balanced on offense and be able to move the ball." Defensively, he says the team "has

got to be a lot more physical.' "We've got to get better linebacker play. I feel good about our defensive line. They're proving to be physical and getting after folks. We've just got to start trusting each other. We've got a lot of people in new places and everything. We've gotta have everybody understanding how to do their job, and to do it effectively and consistently and not try to do somebody else's job and stay in position.

Comer spoke about the season opener and hosting their rival Huntingdon Mustangs, a game which is a big point of pride, but has absolutely no playoff implications. "Well, it makes camp interesting. We've got our work cut out for us. It's a huge game for us and for them, too. It means a lot to the fans and the community, the school. It's a fun opener, and we understand the significance of the game and we've gotta get prepared."

The Rebels don't begin region play until Week 5, which gives them time to work some things out. Comer said, "The region [7-2A] is gonna be tough, just like it was last year. It's tough top-to-bottom, one of the toughest regions in the whole state. You've got five schools that have been to the state championship or won the state championship in the same region. They all expect to be in the playoffs every year, but somebody's gonna get left out. It's a dogfight."

The Rebels begin the season on Friday, August 17 at home against Huntingdon. Region 7-2A play will begin Friday, September 14 on the road at Trinity Christian Academy in Jackson.

Gleason Head Football Coach Noah Lampkins spoke to The Banner during the Bulldogs' Media Day, expressing optimism and confidence about his team.

It's a young team, featuring ten freshmen to replace last vear's five seniors. The rookies make up nearly half of the 21man roster, but that's up from 19 last year.

The Bulldogs are coming off of a 2-8 season, but that followed back-to-back one-win







VETERAN WAR EAGLE TEAM COULD HAVE WEST CARROLL BACK IN PLAYOFFS

A lack of experience shouldn't

be an issue for the 2018 West Carroll War Eagles.

The War Eagles return experience at almost every single position. All total, 18 starters are back from last years 4-6 campaign that left them one game shy of a playoff berth. Two turnovers against Greenfield during the final game of the season cost the War Eagles a post season bid. West Carroll hasn't been to the playoffs now in six seasons.

But with a veteran class of seniors 12 strong and a bunch of experience on both sides of the ball, that should change this season.

Fourth year head coach Josh Wolfe makes no bones about the goals for this years team.

"We just missed the playoffs last year so that's something we want to accomplish," said Wolfe. "We've had a really good preseason and we had a good spring too. We played Houston County pretty even in the spring but really got after them this summer and won 4 touchdowns to nothing."

Playing with a roster of about 35, Wolfe knows his team needs to work the clock and control the tempo of his opponents.

"We've got to be able to run the ball first because like most 1A schools, our roster is limited," explained Wolfe. "We need to be able to control the tempo and cut down on the number of snaps. I'm old school so we're going to run it most of the time but I also want to be able to throw when we want to—not just when we need to. We've got some kids that can create big plays in space and we

need to take advantage of that." The War Eagles have 9 starters back running their single wing offense using a two back set.

In the trenches, 5 out of six starters return for WCHS. But they also return most of their backfield and receivers—four of which run the 40-yard dash in 4.6 seconds or better.

Across the front, Levi Hays (5-8, 250) will play center with Blake Davidson (5-8, 200) at left guard and Garrett Brooks holding down the right guard slot. At left tackle, big Luke Blankenship (6-5, 230) will lead the way. At RT, Darrell Williams (5-9, 255) will get the start. Armoni Bonds will also join the crowd up front in tight sets.

In the backfield, Trace Fuller will return at QB with Jeremiah Bryant being the go-to tailback, along with speedster P.J. Odom.

Jarruis Weatherford is listed as the most dynamic ball carrier on the team, and will bring big play potential to the War Eagle attack. Zach Perry, Shae Crocker and Devin Nash are also listed as capable ball carriers by coach Wolfe.

The War Eagle defense also returns 9 starters to their 3-4 scheme, with many of the same names on that side of the ball. Added to that however is Devin Nash and third year starter Kyler White at defensive end. Perry will call the shots from linebacker, where he logged nearly 100 tackles a year ago.

In the defensive backfield, Crocker will join returning starters Odom and Bryant.

Nash will also take care of kicking and punting duties.

Coach Wolfe said if his team can stay healthy and avoid depth issues, they could potentially be good enough to compete for the Region 7-1A championship.


"There's no question Lake County is the big dog in the region," Wolfe admitted. "Dresden lost some good linemen but they've got a bunch of good skill people back. Humboldt is always talented and we expect Greenfield to be very competitive."

The War Eagles open the season with Bruceton on Aug. 17, a team that has beat them two years in a row.

"With our experience, I think we can compete for a region championship," the coach concluded "We'll take it one game at a time and hope when the opportunity comes, we're ready to take advantage of it."

In addition to his head coaching duties, Wolfe oversees quarterbacks, wide receivers and linebackers.

Assisting Wolfe this season will be Shane DePriest, who will oversee running backs and linebackers; Larry Williams will coach offensive linemen and defensive backs; and Alex Giannini, the coach over offensive and defensive lines.

knows the fans will come out even more than they might in the middle of the season, when the teams have established themselves for better or worse. He noted that he would have appreciated being more polished for the rivalry game.


The coach isn't sure what to make of the region this year. He's only seen Collinwood (on tape), who he says looks much improved. He knows that Wayne County will always be in the mix.
