

FEDERAL AND STATE WITH MUNICIPALS ELECTION, NOVEMBER 8, 2022: NOTICE TO ELDERLY VOTERS AND VOTERS WITH DISABILITIES IN CARROLL COUNTY

An elderly voter (60 years of age or older) or a voter with a disability, whose polling place is not accessible, may vote early or Election Day at the Election office. If the voter chooses to vote at the Election office on Election Day, the voter must complete an affidavit by October 29, 2022, stating that the voter's designated voting location does not comply with the provisions of Public Law 98-435 of the 98th Congress.

As an alternative to voting at the Election office on Election Day, **the voter may vote by absentee ballot or during the Early Voting period.** *Note* – if the voter registered to vote by mail, the voter must vote in-person in the first election in which the voter votes. The absentee ballot request deadline is November 1, 2022.

CURRENT OR OLD TENNESSEE PHOTO ID IS REQUIRED TO VOTE IN PERSON. EARLY VOTING is only in the Election office and will be October 19-November 3, 2022, 8:30 a.m.-4 p.m., Monday-Friday and Saturdays (10/22 & 10/29), 9 a.m.-NOON. All voters are eligible to vote early. The deadline to register to vote for this election is October 11, 2022.
