RULING/ORDER

Hearing was held August 28, 2023: City of McKenzie vs. Owners of property located at 307 Linden Street, McKenzie, Tennessee 38201, Parcel 21, Group F, of Tax Map 12M.

This cause came to be heard on August 28, 2023, by the below hearing officer. This cause was initiated by the City of McKenzie alleging a violation of City Ordinance section 13-201 involving slum clearance.

Present at the hearing of August 28, 2023, was codes officer Jim Seaton on behalf of the City of McKenzie. The following property maintenance committee members were also in attendance: Police Chief Ryan White, Fire Chief Brian Tucker, Mayor Ryan Griffin, and City Recorder Jennifer Waldrup. Codes Consultant Jim Pillow was also in attendance. Micki Hall, daughter of property owners Joseph P. Jordan and Nellie Jordan was also in attendance. Ms. Hall stated that both of her parents were deceased. The hearing officer finds that all interested parties were properly notified before said hearing pursuant to proper notice as required.

The hearing officer finds that the City of McKenzie has carried its burden of proof under the ordinance and that there is a basis for a finding of unfitness under section 13-209. The owners have ninety days (90) days from September 19, 2023, to pull the proper permits and repair or demolish the structure. Any possible appeal, in accordance with Section 13-211, of this order, must be within sixty (60) days after the posting and service of this order of the public officer.
