## **Backhoe Operator**

The City of McKenzie is accepting applications for a backhoe operator. Candidate must be 18 years of age, possess a valid driver's license, high school diploma or its equivalent and pass the pre-employment drug screen. Applications will be accepted at city hall until 4 p.m. on January 22.

- Applicant is also expected to work on the crew, so must be able to perform manual labor, stooping, bending twisting and lifting heavy weight at times.
- Job consist of learning to maintain and repair water lines, fire hydrants and related equipment. Install water pipe and make repairs to water lines.
- Participate on emergency call out when needed for water line/water main breaks.
