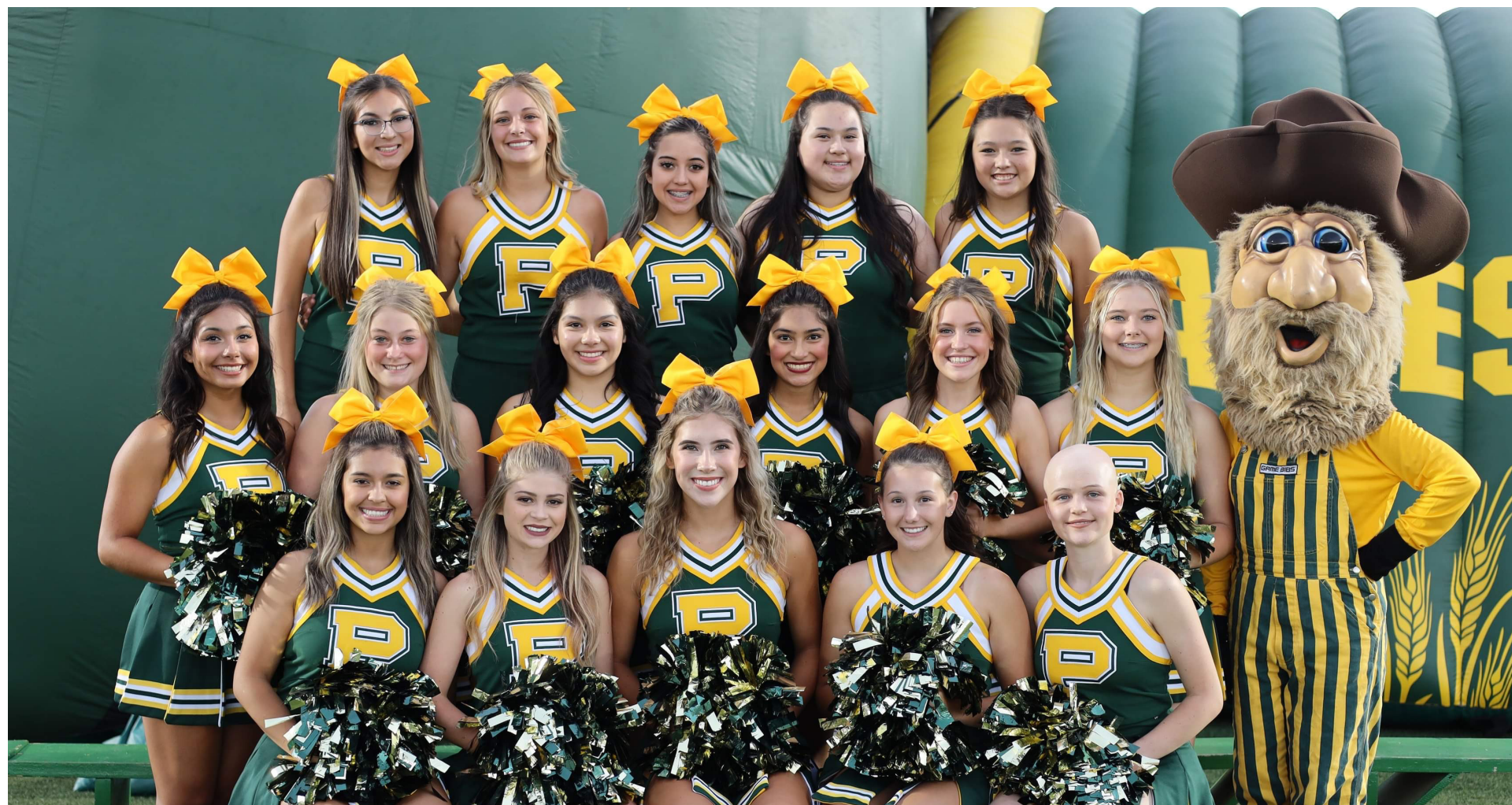

In addition to painting megaphones and looking after her grandson, Roberson works at the Madeline Graves Performing Arts Center during the evening. Though her day is filled with many adventures, Roberson always finds a way to balance painting and life's daily activities.

"I paint at night," Roberson said. "I have a little shop by my house so I can paint at home. Aside from decorating megaphones, I do little projects for people like paint chairs. As long as I can get it into my shop, I can do it."

Roberson has painted megaphones for the cheerleaders across the panhandle. From Pampa to Borger, cheerleaders have had their megaphones customized to highlight their unique personalities. The megaphones are adorned with colorful hand painted details that show the interests of each cheerleader.

Roberson reflects upon the countless megaphones she's painted. Her amazing work has reached far beyond the panhandle area. Roberson has painted several megaphones for cheerleaders in

Dallas and South Texas. She is in the process of sending her work to Louisiana and Florida.

"I think they're all absolutely one of a kind. There's something on all of them that I've loved or been my favorite," Roberson said. "I truly enjoy painting megaphones."

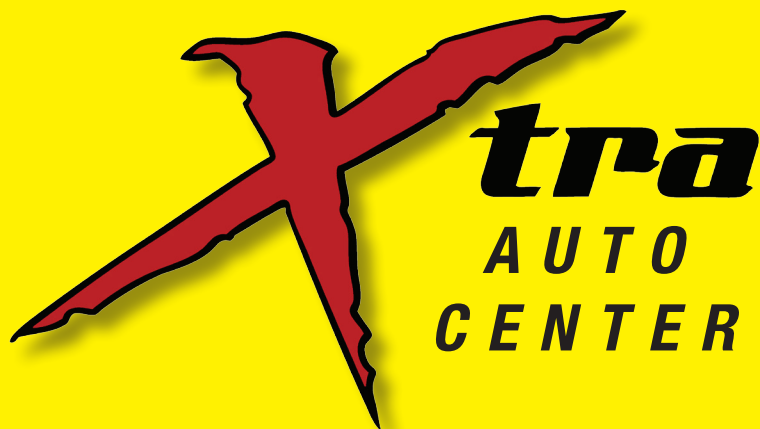
