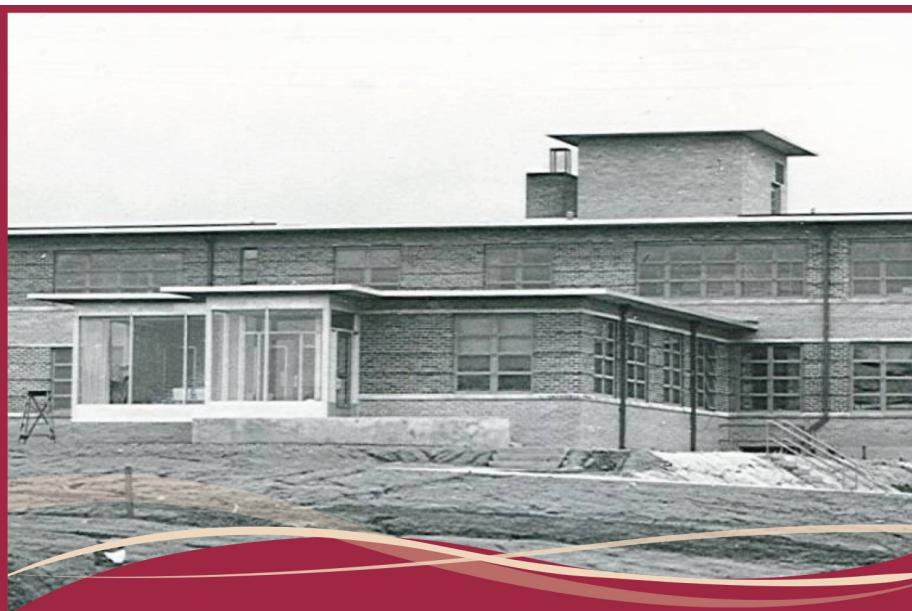

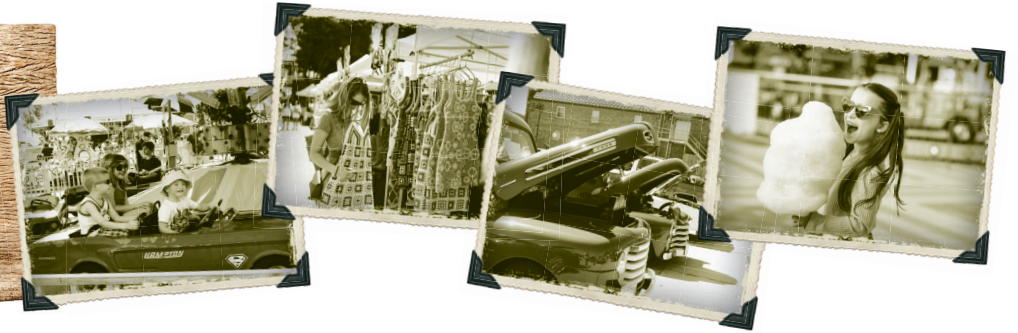

From February 1923 through May 1936, the minutes were written in a hardbound notebook, which the Chamber still has in its possession. Mayfest craft fair expected to bring thousands

One of the Mayfest's main attractions is set to bring in droves of people this year. The Mayfest craft fair kicks off on Saturday, May 13 at 9 a.m.

"This is a great event every year," Perryville Area Chamber of Commerce Operations Manager Renee Lottes said. "We have a variety of booths that offer many different things for the people that come out, also we have a lot of new crafters coming in this year."

Lottes said the craft fair has 130 vendors rented out by vendors already with the hopes for more before the event. Every space is rented on St. Joseph and Main Streets this year and new

vendors will be placed on South Jackson near H Squared.

Lottes expects a lot of people to come out and walk around the craft fair.

"I have a picture from last year where I don't even know how people walked," she said. "Everyone was elbow to elbow and the vendors said it was one of their best days at our craft fair."

There will be plenty for the residents of Perryville and beyond to choose from this year at the craft fair. There will be quilts and blankets, toys, woodworking items, dog accessories, jewelry and metal items, purses and more.

"This is a great time to buy things for the mothers out there," Lottes said. "I think that's part of the reason that everyone does so well here. The Mayfest is on Mother's Day weekend and everyone is looking for something."

Lottes is excited for the craft fair again this year.

"This is one of my favorite events of the year and it should be a great one again," she said.

2023 Mayfest 5K RUN/WALK

looks to be crowded once again

If a person wanted to kick Mayfest off with a little morning jog, they are in luck. The Perry Park Center will host its annual Mayfest 5K Run/Walk Saturday, May 13. Recreation Supervisor Cindy Huck is excited about the event, with this being one of the first events she has planned, since being hired earlier this year.

"I've run in some before, but I've never had the opportunity to plan one," she said.

Registration is open from now until the time of the event. Signups begin at 7 a.m. on that Saturday and run until 7:45 a.m. The registration fee is \$15.

The course will not change from last year's event that started and ended at the Park Center and wound throughout the City Park.

"We haven't made any major changes to the route or the event itself," Huck said.



Huck noted that there are already about 60 participants signed up, and they are expecting more than 100 runners on race day.

"That's a great number for us," she said. "We hope we can have some good weather for the race and everyone has a good time."

Each participant is guaranteed a t-shirt if they registered before the early bird date on April 25. Any entry received after the early deadline is not guaranteed a shirt on race day, but they will be available while supplies last.

Awards will be handed out for the top overall male and top female runners as well as the top three in each age division. Top winners will also win shoes from Roziers.

"They haven't done that for several years," she said. "So it's nice to have Roziers associated with the event."

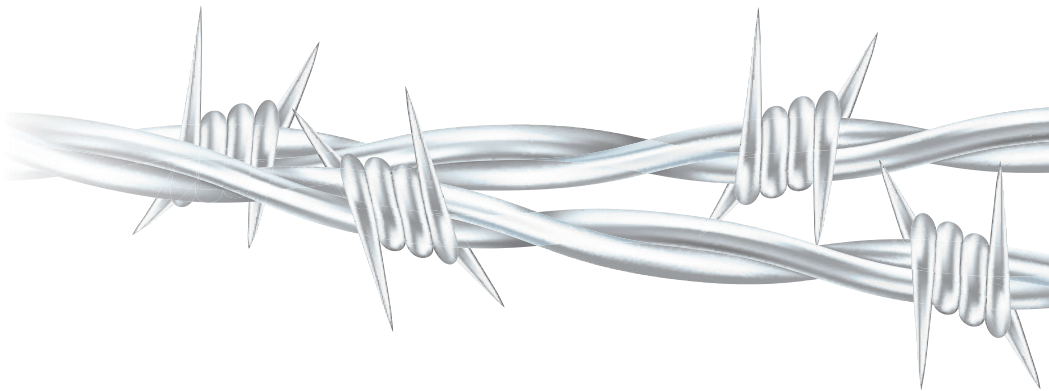

Beth Yamnitz of American Homes Realty is hoping for some good weather during this year Mayfest.

She is hoping that the annual decorated diaper and diaper derby contests can happen once again this year.

"It's just a way to bring everyone together and who doesn't enjoy things that involve babies," she said.



In the past Mother Nature has had other plans as rain has really hampered the event in recent years. The derby is about finding the quickest (or fastest) baby.

"Our diaper derby is simply who can crawl to the finish line the quickest," Yamnitz said.

Five or six babies participate at a time. If a second heat is needed, they go ahead and do that.

"It's really cute," Yamnitz said.

The race will take place at the Downtown Plaza Stage as babies race across the finish line. The babies should be 0-12 months and must be accompanied by an adult. Coaches can use toys and other incentives to help the baby cross the finish line, but can't physically do so. If no baby crosses the finish line in five minutes, than the closest participant is declared the winner.

Participants can sign up in advance or on race day.

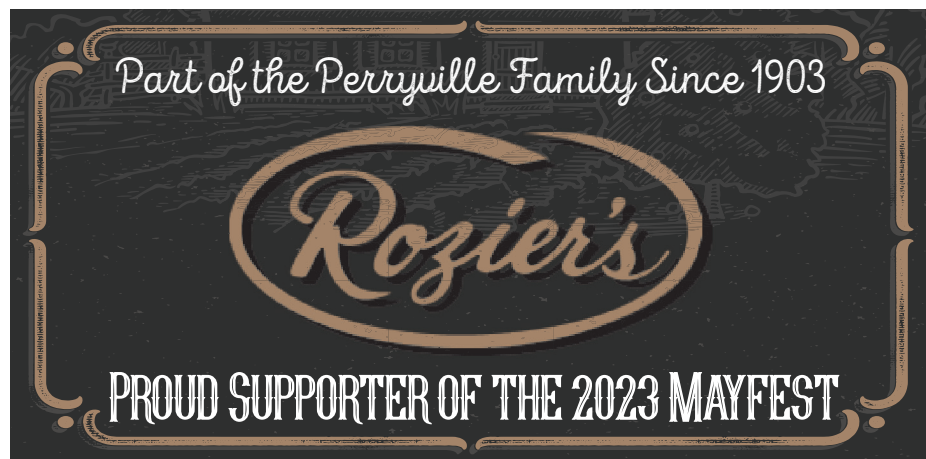

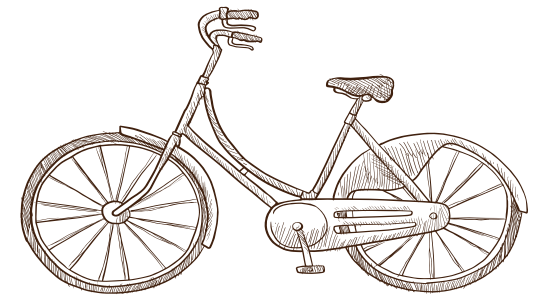

People who love the outdoors should be glad to know there is something for them this year at the Mayfest. For the second consecutive year there will be mountain bike and caving exhibits on Jackson Street.

The exhibits will begin at 11 a.m. and will feature information about local caving will have the opportunity to educate themselves. Perry County has thousands of caves, many of which can be explored by those who know where to look.

Last year, one of the features of the caving exhibit was a “squeeze

box,” for individuals to try wiggling their way through close quarters to simulate crawling through the tight spaces normally found in caves. People were also able to view caving gear.

Perryville is starting to dip its toe in the area of biking, so it only makes sense that there will be a mountain biking exhibit as well. There are biking opportunities being developed near Legion Lake.


