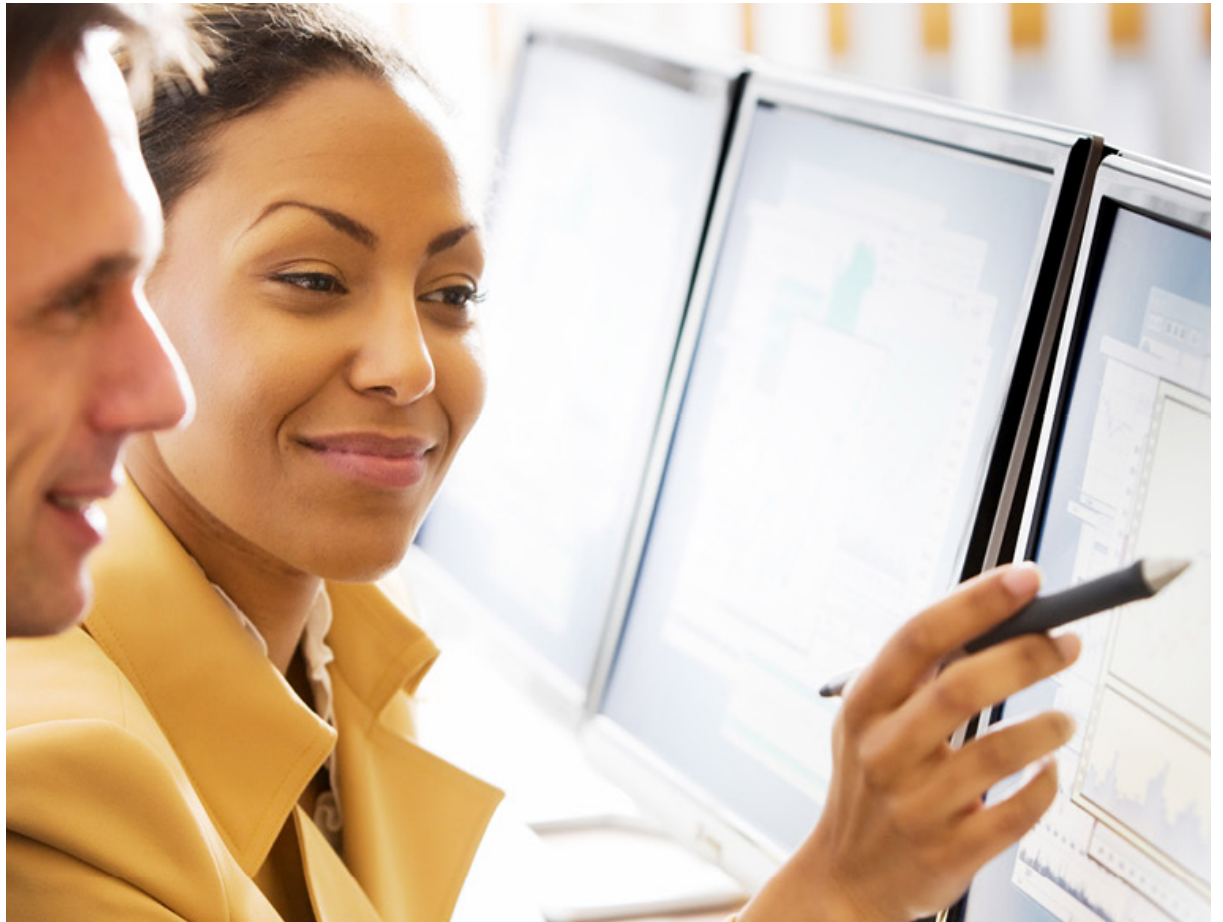

Much of the menu is still the same today, as the Buchheit family pays homage to its founder.

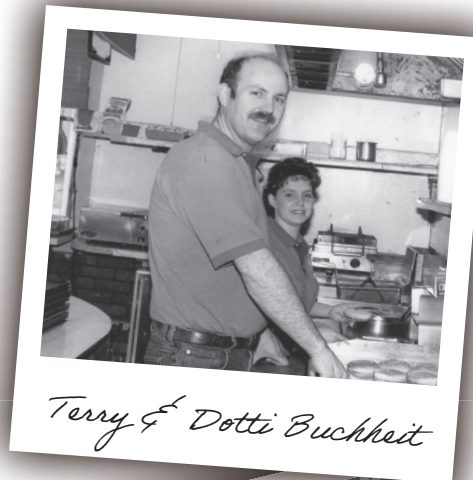

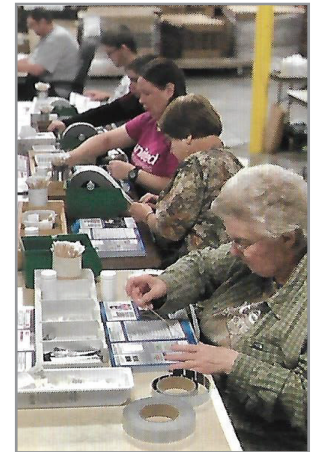

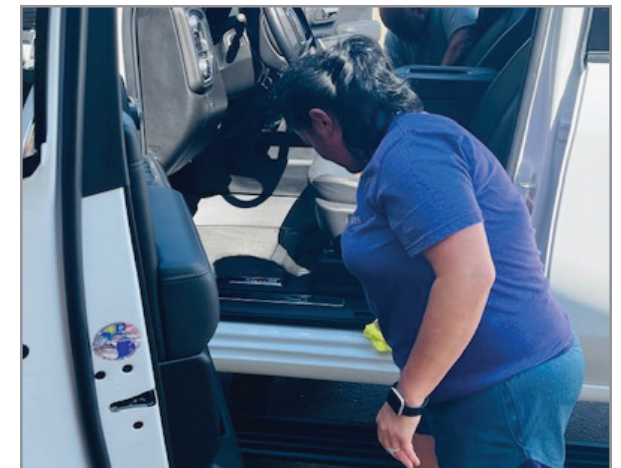

The building housing VG was built in 1885 and has a rich and varied history. Slowly the interior has been renovated. Eventually the exterior will be restored to as much of the original grandeur as possible. Being lovers of art, when the Bammels were approached by the Heritage and Tourism Committee they jumped at the chance to have an historically based mural painted on the side of the building by Artist Craig Thomas.
