

NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY COMPLIANCE WITH TITLE VI CIVIL RIGHTS ACT

Weakley County Rehabilitation & Nursing Center, in Dresden, Tennessee, in compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, is non-discriminatory in its admission policy with regard to race, color, or national origin. Medical records, services and physical facilities provided by the nursing home are available to patients without distinction or discrimination as to race, color, or national origin. All persons and organizations having occasion, either to refer patients for admission or to recommend to Weakley County Rehabilitation & Nursing Center are advised to do so without regard to patient's race, color, or national origin. Physician privileges are granted on a non-discriminatory basis.

Weakley County Rehabilitation & Nursing Center is also in compliance with Section 504, which provides for non-discrimination of handicapped persons. The physical facility is accessible to handicapped patients, visitors and all representatives of the public. Treatment is provided for all patients at the intermediate level of care regardless of the type of handicap. Special provisions have been made for the hard-of-hearing and the blind.
