



# Communities Continue Tradition Of Decorating Parade Floats

efore the cookouts and fireworks, Severna Park residents celebrate the Fourth of July by lining the streets to watch the Greater Severna Park and Arnold Chamber of Commerce's parade go by.

There are many staples of the parade: free candy getting tossed to spectators, antique cars taking a spin, and the decorated parade floats.



"The Severna Park [and] Arnold restaurant community is perhaps small, but we are active and we are passionate," Koukoulis said. "Restaurant Week is an opportunity to remind local diners that we have plenty to offer."

At Cakes and Confections, customers will be offered a free dessert with any combo lunch special.

"It's a great opportunity not only to see some of our regular customers enjoy a free dessert but also to bring in new customers who didn't realize we serve breakfast and lunch," said owner Julianne Brown. "And we always like to support the chamber and encourage people to shop local."

Chris Johnston, director of operations at 206 Restaurant Group, which oversees Park Tavern, said his team is always looking for more ways to be involved in the community.

"Restaurant Week provides us an outlet to highlight some of our chef's specialties while giving our guests a little more variety when they dine with us," Johnston said. "It's a fun way to introduce some new items and highlight things we've been working on for possible upcoming menu items."

Eddie Conway, owner of Garry's Grill, said Restaurant Week provides another way to give back to the community.

"Restaurant Week is a way for us to say thank you to the guests who have patronized my establishment and

also allows us to gain new guests at the same time," Conway said.

For those who might have forgotten, there is a 10-foot American flag that hangs in Founders Tavern & Grille year-round.

"We are Founders, so we are all about the Fourth of July and this country's rich history," said Janet Sumner, co-owner of Founders. "What a great way to give our families in the community something to look forward to midsummer between school and vacation breaks, to heal the midsummer woes by having somewhere fun to take the family and experience this great food in our area, and at a discount."

With Severna Park's restaurant scene continuing to grow, League hopes Restaurant Week does, too.

It is so exciting that our community has grown enough to attract high-quality eateries where we can have a Restaurant Week," League said. "Our goal is to make Restaurant Week a staple in the community and something people and the restaurant owners look forward to each year."
