



Annapolis School Of Seamanship Provides Summertime Fun And New Skills Through Junior Captains Program

his summer, the Annapolis School of Seamanship is again offering its popular Junior Captains courses for kids.

"Students will gain the knowledge and confidence to safely operate a small boat by themselves," said Mark Talbott, operations manager at the Annapolis School of Seamanship. "They will have a fun week out on the water, while also learning valuable skills and safe powerboat operation."

The school, considered a leader in the education of professional and recreational boaters, has been holding classes for adults since 2002. The year-round classes are offered on a wide range of nau-

tical topics, including hands-on diesel engine, marine electrical systems, navigation, weather and captain's license courses. Just as with the adult on-water classes, all course instructors are also U.S. Coast Guard licensed captains.

The Junior Captains course was launched in 2018 and has since helped hundreds of local kids gain experience and confidence operating small powerboats. This year, for the first time, the classes will run from Annapolis City Marina, right across the creek from, and with a beautiful view of, downtown Annapolis and City Dock. Enrollment in the Junior Captains course also includes access to online training materials for the

duration of the class.

"We were unable to have the classroom portion of the course held in-person last year, so we moved that training online, and it has worked very well," Talbott said. "Students review the material the evening before and then get right out on the water and put the knowledge into practice when they arrive each day."

The Junior Captains course focuses on the fundamentals of boat operation: docking and close quarters maneuvering, how to operate at speed and how to safely tow a tube on single outboard training vessels. Other skills learned while out on the water include rules of the road, aids to navigation,

and weather. Back at the docks, instructors teach safety equipment, pre-departure checks, and how to use VHF (very high frequency) radios.

For graduates of Junior Captains courses, the Annapolis School of Seamanship offers a level II course. This course builds on the students' boating skills and knowledge and covers more in-depth training on rules of the road and navigation. Students learn electronic navigation, using chartplotters to navigate to locations using waypoints and routes.

To make sure each student gets plenty of wheel time, each course is limited to just four
