

API Camps Provide Safe Environment For Summer Fun

or many kids, the summer is a time of freedom. The season gives them the independence to wander, to play, and to explore new and beloved hobbies.

At Athletic Performance Inc. (API) in Gambrills, kids can get the best of both worlds. They can enjoy those activities while also developing their athletic abilities in a safe environment.

"If I'm a parent, I'm looking to send my kids somewhere that is proven and established," said Stephen Vaught, API's founder and president. "Somewhere they will feel comfortable."

API offers wide-ranging All-Sport Kids Academy camps, sport-specific camps, junior camps for ages 3.5 to 6, and STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art and math) camps.

All-Sport Kids Academy is designed to build confidence, character and athletic skills in soccer, tennis, baseball, lacrosse, football, basketball, and more while emphasizing fun and sportsmanship. These camps are for kids ages 6 to 14.

"It's important that kids are active and being social," Vaught said. "They're not at home playing video games while mom and dad are at work. We're not developing the next Ray Lewis or Alex Rodriguez in the All-Sport Kids Academy, but it's a fun day camp."

The program director, Amy Shaffer, keeps each day fun with a different agenda. For example, one theme is water day. Every day has a different curriculum, lunch and treat, and API partners with Chick-fil-A, Newk's Eatery and Vocelli Pizza for several of the meals.

All-Sport Kids Academy includes a full-day camp from 8:00am to 5:00pm and half-day camps from 8:00am to 12:30pm and from 12:30pm to 5:00pm. The camps run for 11 weeks from June 20 to September 2.

Beginner and intermediate athletes who are serious about improving their skills can take their game to the next level by attending a sport-specific camp. API offers camps for baseball, boys lacrosse, girls lacrosse, basketball, field hockey and tennis. Many of the coaches are collegiate athletes who have been through API camps.

While most sport-specific camps are from 9:00am to noon, API has evening camps for field hockey and full-day camp options for baseball and basketball.

"A full day of camp can be tough for kids, keeping their attention, but our middle school showcase is different," Vaught said, speaking about a baseball camp. "The showcase will have guest speakers and we'll have high school coaches here. It's not just drills, drills, drills."

All-Sport Kids Academy also partners with Coder Kids Club/ Pongo's Learning Lab to provide STEAM classes for kids in kindergarten through eighth grade. Kids will make sticky, slimy, fizzy and fluffy stuff out of everyday materials. Camp participants will also spend time learning about gross stuff, like boogers, farts, germs and more. If your child previously attended this camp, many of the experiments will be the same, but some new ones have been added.

API has a 1-to-6 coach to child ratio for its sport-specific summer camps, Vaught said. The team also has the flexibility to meet outdoors or indoors, depending on the weather.

API's goal is to give kids all the tools for a fun and rewarding summer, while fostering an enthusiasm for sports.

"It's important that kids have this outlet," Vaught said. "They can work on their craft and learn from great coaches, but kids still have to be kids during the summer."
