# Holiday Recipes

### Coquito

#### Recipe from Goska's Liquors

Coquito may translate to "little coconut," but this recipe is big in flavor. It is a great alternative to traditional eggnog.

#### **Ingredients**

- 1 15 oz can of cream of coconut
- 1 14 oz can of sweetened condensed milk
- 1 12 oz evaporated milk
- 1 cup of unsweetened coconut milk
- 1/2 cup of white rum
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon grated nutmeg

#### **Directions**

- Combine all ingredients in a large glass pitcher and refrigerate for at least one hour
- Stir before serving and top with freshly grated nutmeg





## Chesapeake Deviled Eggs

#### Recipe from Chef Carlo Biondi at Rams Head Tavern Annapolis

What is a holiday get-together without deviled eggs? This recipe offers some Maryland flare on this classic dish.

#### **Ingredients**

- 12 fresh eggs
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1 tablespoon sour cream
- 2 teaspoons Dijon mustard
- 2 tablespoons horseradish
- 1 sprig fresh dill
- 1 pound lump crabmeat
- 1 teaspoon Old Bay seasoning
- Salt and pepper to taste

#### **Directions**

- In a medium pot of boiling water, place eggs and cook for 8 minutes
- Remove from water and let cool
- Peel the eggs and cut them in half lengthwise and push the yoke out into a mixing bowl
- Add all ingredients except the dill, lump crab and Old Bay
- Mix until smooth and evenly incorporated, add salt and pepper to taste, then place into piping bag
- Pipe the filling into the egg halves
- Remove the stems from the dill and finely chop
- Finish the eggs with a pinch of crab meat and a pinch of dill
- Sprinkle Old Bay over the eggs in place of the paprika used in traditional recipes

#### Venison Valdostana

#### Recipe from Cafe Mezzanotte

This dish is an elevated twist on the classic veal or chicken "valdostana," a dish originating in the Val d'Aosta region of northwest Italy, typically prepared with fontina Val d'Aosta cheese and shaved prosciutto.

#### **Ingredients**

- Venison (deer) loin
- Fontina Val d'Aosta cheese
- Prosciutto (preferably di parma)
- Juniper berry

- Fresh sage
- Fresh rosemary
- Puff pastry
- Egg
- Demi-glace sauce

#### **Directions**

- Trim fat from venison loin, cut into 8 oz filet medallions
- Prepare venison rub
- Crush juniper berries, let partially dry (under heat lamp or at low temp in oven)
- Dice fresh sage and rosemary (leaves only)
- Combine ingredients with sea salt and coarse pepper
- Coat venison medallions with extra virgin olive oil, then encrust with rub
- Roast medallions in oven at 450 degrees (no fan) for 8-10 minutes until cooked rare
- Place aside to cool
- Let puff pastry come to room temperature, then cut square out of puff pastry
- Sprinkle coarse black pepper atop puff pastry and press into dough



- Place venison medallion atop black pepper puff pastry, top with shaved fontina cheese
- Wrap venison and cheese with thinly shaved prosciutto di parma
- Wrap puff pastry around everything, with the four corners of dough meeting beneath the medallion
- Brush puff pastry with beaten whole egg
- Cook in oven for 450 degrees for approximately 15-20 minutes, until venison is medium rare to medium
- Once removed from the oven, let venison rest for 3-5 minutes before cutting open down the center
- Simmer your demi-glace sauce and lightly drizzle over your dish, and Buon Appetito!
- \*For best results (and as served at the restaurant), serve with creamy butternut squash polenta, honey cumin glazed Thumbelina carrot, and fresh snipped pea tendrils.

### Thai Curry

#### Recipe from Oishi Japanese Cuisine

This staple of Thai cuisine is rich and creamy.

#### **Ingredients**

- 2 cans of 400 ml coconut milk
- 4 oz of water
- 1 can of 4 oz green/red curry paste
- -2 leaves of lime leaf (cut in strips)
- 4 oz sugar
- 4 oz fish sauce
- 4 leaves of Thai basil

#### **Directions**

- Preheat pan to medium heat
- Add oil
- Add lime leaf; cook for 1 minute
- Add curry paste
- Mix curry paste and lime leaves
- Add more oil and keep stirring for 2 minutes
- Add coconut milk, water, sugar and fish sauce
- Continue stirring
- Let all ingredients to cook for 3 minutes
- Add protein

- Add your favorite vegetables
- Cook for 5 minutes
- Add Thai basil and cook for 1 minute
- Turn off fire and mix all ingredients
- Serve in a bowl and get ready to eat



# Start A New Family Tradition To Celebrate The Season Of Giving

or most Marylanders, November is the time to start planning holiday extravaganzas. A Thanksgiving feast with family or friends, a New Year's Eve party to welcome 2024 in style, or one of the many religious traditions that will be celebrated into early January. Gifts will be purchased, along with lots of food and drinks.

As we make our lists and check them at least twice, it's important to remember our neighbors who may face these celebratory weeks with dread, stress or even fear.

In an April 2022 interview, Anne Arundel County Exec-

utive Steuart Pittman told Channel 2 WMAR Baltimore that more than 300 homeless individuals reside in our county. In that same news segment, Housing Commission of Anne Arundel County CEO Clif Martin stated that more than 30,000 families were waiting for rental assistance or Section 8 housing. For thousands of people in Anne Arundel County, there will be no home for the holidays.

Many people with housing may not have adequate food. The United States Department of Agriculture defines food insecurity as the lack of access, at times, to enough food for an active, healthy life. A 2021 Map the Meal Gap survey by Feeding America, conducted through corporate funding,

determined that 47,260 people living in Anne Arundel County lacked proper nutrition.

Additionally, in a 2021 survey by Cambridge Semantics (www.welfareinfo.org) nearly 6% of Anne Arundel County residents live in poverty. Though below the national average of nearly 13% — and 10.3% in Maryland — 33,476 Anne Arundel County residents live in poverty.

Whether someone is lacking proper housing, nutrition or financial stability, the winter months are hardly the most wonderful time of the year.

Thankfully, generosity abounds in Anne Arundel County. Organizations like Giving Back: Linda's Legacy, Severna Park Assistance Network (SPAN) and Asbury Church Assistance Network Inc. (ACAN), to name a few, are addressing community needs. These volunteer-run organizations need assistance more than ever to make the holidays a little brighter for our less-fortunate neighbors. Whether you can donate your time, food and material items, gift cards or cash, there are many opportunities for you, your family, groups or businesses to assist right here in our area.

Jeanette Middleton Sudano, Giving Back: Linda's Legacy's executive director since 2015, said that looking at human crises globally can be overwhelming, however, "if everybody

does their part in small, loving and intentional actions, the collective impact will positively help a lot of people."

#### **GIVING BACK: LINDA'S LEGACY**

Since 2003, Linda's Legacy has organized a large-scale drive for homeless individuals and families in Baltimore and Anne Arundel counties. Clothing and toiletry donations are collected throughout November and December and delivered to shelters on Christmas Eve and in the days immediately before Christmas.

The effort is massive. Middleton Sudano estimates that

more than 600 volunteers will help 9,000 people this year.

"Every year, I wonder how we will be able to pull this off, and every year with the help of God, our volunteers do it," Middleton Sudano said. "God provides. He always does."

Schools, businesses, individuals and families all get involved. Schools like Severna Park Middle School, Severn School and School of the Incarnation — among numerous others — stuff the 3,000 backpacks needed for shelter deliveries or host coat and toiletry drives. Families, clubs and organizations like Girl Scouts bake cakes and decorate cookies to drop off at shelters.



"We have tremendous need for volunteers of all ages, from individuals, families and companies," Middleton Sudano said. "And I am grateful for every single one. Volunteering together as a family or group is especially rewarding."



Asbury Church Assistance Network, located at 429 Asbury Drive in Severna Park, has been helping people for decades. The organization offers a unique "drive thru" food pantry where qualified individuals will receive prepackaged food boxes of dried and canned goods, fresh vegetables, dairy and meat. ACAN also offers a baby pantry, personal hygiene items, and when possible, home delivery. ACAN plans to provide 400 Thanksgiving meals, and support dozens of families with gifts and food for Christmas.

Peggy Wilson is the executive director for ACAN.

"We've seen a 20% increase in the number of people coming during the week for food," said Wilson, who also commented that her phone is flooded with people needing holiday assistance. "I cannot even tell you how many people we will help over Christmas yet, but the need is great and only getting greater."

Wilson explained that ACAN will serve approximately 80 cars a day on the three weekdays the food pantry is open, totaling 240 cars a week. Each car represents an average family size of five or six people, which equals approximately 1,300 Anne Arundel County residents each week.

#### Other Ways To Help


If you or your family are looking for other ways to help your less-fortunate neighbors, here are other options to consider.

If your local school does not have a similar program, ask for information on other schools in the county where the need is greater.

Contact the activity director or administrator to find out when events like bingo or other social gatherings will take place so your family can participate, or offer to host a holiday party with your group. Many facilities welcome carolers and musicians to entertain residents.
- **4.** Organize a neighborhood caroling event. Make sure to stop at homes where elderly or widowed people reside and offer a festive song or two to make their holiday merrier.
- **5.** Send Christmas and New Year's cards to members of the military. The United Soldiers and Sailors of America organization (*www.usasoa.org*) is accepting holiday cards through December 5 to ensure on-time overseas delivery. Gather your family around the dining room table and let the troops know they are remembered.

Get creative. Remember, small acts of kindness add up to a big impact. This year, share your family's good fortune with others and make the season of giving a new family tradition.

## ELVES FOR ELDERS BRINGS HOLIDAY CHEER TO SENIORS

oining Partners In Care was a revelation for Sue Origlio in 2014.

"I thought, This place is too good to be true," Origlio said. "It's just people helping each other."

Her mom was one of those people, addressing 180 to 300 birthday cards each month to members of Partners In Care, which helps older adults live independently in their homes and stay active in their

Soon, Origlio had a project of her own: Elves for Elders, a stocking-stuffing endeavor that serves seniors each December.

Elves for Elders would not only make the holidays merrier for seniors, she thought, but it was an ideal way to honor her father, who died in 2015.

"This is something so simple, but you see how much it means to somebody," Origlio said. "You can get caught up in your own families and lives, but there are people out there who are all alone with no signs of Christmas.

"Even if only for that day when they call Partners In Care, a lot of people are in tears and they say, You made my day. I didn't think anyone would remember

The fundraiser will return this year on December 2 from 3:00pm to 7:00pm. For the first time. Elves for Elders will be held at Brian Boru Irish Restaurant and Pub in Severna Park instead of being held in Gambrills.

Origlio dined at the restaurant last Thanksgiving and noticed that general manager Kendall Yingling shared her enthusiasm for helping the elderly population.

"They were just so warm, all the waiters and waitresses," Origlio said. "I thought, This is where we

Yingling said although Brian Boru Irish Restaurant and Pub hosts an average of three fundraisers per week, Elves for Elders is special.

"A lot of the drives that are done are focused on children and families with children." Yingling said. "This is focused on our community elders who might not have family, or their family might not see them anymore and they might be on the backburner. The way (Sue) explained it, it really sparked a light in my heart."

The event is bittersweet for Origlio. Her mom passed away in May 2020, nearly five years after the death of Origlio's father. Her parents were childhood sweethearts.


Partners In Care asked Origlio if she wanted to take a year off.

"My mother would be telling me, 'Don't you let these people down. They are even more isolated now,"" Origlio said.

Origlio called the response "unbelievable."

Elves for Elders has grown each year. Origlio and her helpers stuffed 80 stockings in 2015. Volunteers stuffed more than 400 stockings in 2022.

Many people have told Partners In Care that they felt the stockings were made for them personally.



"I think the Christmas stockings bring them back to their childhood," Origlio said. "They all are surprised, like whoever did the stocking knew them. And they don't. It's the luck of the draw. But (the recipients) get personalized notes."

Origlio called Elves for Elders "my Christmas." Words hardly explain the joy she feels when seeing people gather to support seniors at a time when their energy and mobility levels may be decreased, they may feel the loss of their independence, or they may even feel

"Most of the people who help went to elementary, high school or college with me, and other people get involved and get their family involved, so it's a cool thing the way this has blossomed," Origlio said. "With all the things going on in the world, this is something good but meaningful."


