

Why Core Aeration And Overseeding Matter

s the summer heat wanes and fall approaches, it's time to start thinking about preparing your lawn for the cooler months ahead. One of the most crucial tasks in this process is core aeration and overseeding. These two practices, when combined, can rejuvenate your lawn, ensuring it remains healthy and vibrant year-round.

Why Core Aeration Is Key

Core aeration is the process of removing small plugs



of soil from your lawn. This process plays a critical role in maintaining a healthy lawn as, over time, the soil becomes compacted, especially in high-traffic areas. Compacted soil restricts the movement of air, water and nutrients, making it difficult for grass roots to penetrate and grow.

Core aeration relieves this compaction, allowing your lawn to "breathe" better, and enhances the efficiency of other lawn care practices. For instance, fertilizers and water can more easily reach the root zone, leading to better nutrient absorption and stronger grass.

Additionally, core aeration helps to break down thatch, a layer of dead grass and roots that can suffocate your lawn if it becomes too thick.

The Role Of Overseeding

Overseeding involves spreading new grass seed over your existing lawn. This process fills in bare spots, improves the density of your turf, and introduces more resilient grass varieties that can withstand the stresses of weather, diseases and pests. Overseeding is particularly beneficial for lawns that have experienced thinning due to summer heat, foot traffic or other factors. By introducing fresh grass seed, you're effectively giving your lawn a new

Oil Based Vs. Water Based:

The Truth About Modern Pavement Sealers



n today's day and age, with a plethora of information channels at our fingertips, it can sometimes be difficult to sift through all that information to find what is relevant and accurate. Those who have ever done a sealcoat on their driveway probably have heard the verbiage "oil based" vs. "water based" sealers casually thrown around by friends, neighbors or contractors they have spoken to. Here are the differences:

Many products are made using raw asphalt, which is an extremely viscous byproduct of the oil refining process, called bitumen. These products are used for a variety of purposes including pavement sealers, paving tack coats, waterproofing, roofing materials, etc. The two main categories of products used in pavement sealers can be classified into "asphalt cutbacks" and "emulsions."

Asphalt Cutbacks/ Gilsonite

These are made with raw asphalt (bitumen) dissolved in petroleum solvents, also called distillates. The amount of solvent added impacts the overall product viscosity and cure rate of the asphalt cutback. The most used solvents include naphtha, gasoline, mineral spirits (paint thinner) and kerosene.





A Guide To Fall Plants And Colors

utumn is my favorite time of year. I like it for the cooler temperatures, the fall harvests, Thanksgiving, my birthday and especially the fall colors. It goes without saying that fall is also my favorite time of year to be in the garden.

Since I was a kid, I have been in awe of the colors in autumn landscapes – the deep reds of oakleaf hydrangea, serviceberry's show of oranges, the golden yellow of spicebush, and the carnival of color that is fothergilla – and the processes by which plants prepare themselves for the winter.

During the spring and summer months, trees and shrubs are actively producing chlorophyll so that photosynthesis can occur. As the days get shorter, chlorophyll breaks down and the plant no longer produces replacement molecules. The leaves change colors.

Plants contain pigments called carotenoids. Carotenoids are responsible for the yellows we see in plants in the fall. Though carotenoids are present in all plants, they are overshadowed during the growing season by the green of chlorophyll. Some plants also produce anthocyanins in response to bright light and excess plant sugars within leaf cells. Anthocyanins are responsible for the darker shades of red that certain plants exhibit in autumn.

Temperatures and rainfall leading up to, and during, the fall season impact the intensity of fall colors. Warm, sunny days and cold nights bring about the most impressive color displays. During the warm days, plants continue producing sugars, but the cool nights and the closing of veins in the leaves prevent the sugars from moving out to other parts of the plant. Sugar and light spur production of the anthocyanin pigments, which tint reds and purples. Because carotenoids are always present in leaves, the yellow and gold colors remain fairly constant from year to year.

Rainfall also affects the colors we

see in autumn. That the weather is so unpredictable and variable, no two fall seasons can be the same. A late spring or drought conditions can delay the fall display. An exceptionally warm fall will result in less intense color. A warm wet spring, a fair summer, sunny autumn days and cool nights will result in the most spectacular show of fall colors.

As the summer of 2024 comes to an end, plants are stressed and gardeners are tired. The record heat and the inconsistent rainfall has impacted all of us. Though it is tempting to turn one's back on their garden for fall festivals, football games and camping trips, I'd urge all of my gardening friends to keep on keepin' on. Don't give up now.

Plant your cool weather vegetables, and your cover crops. Plant bulbs and spring-blooming perennials. Amend the soil as you go. And water your plants – especially the newly planted ones. Fall is the ideal time to prepare your garden for the winter, and for the following growing season. Above all, I hope that you take the time in your garden to enjoy the fruits of your labor. Look around you and revel in the colors of fall!

Is Your Home Ready For The New Season?

ith fall and winter on the horizon, preparing your home for the approaching cold months is important. The dramatic change in temperature and weather takes its toll on your home's exterior, so making sure you find potential problem spots before they become a headache is essential. Here are some easy areas a homeowner can inspect to find out how ready they are:

Deck: Inspecting your deck for warped or damaged boards is the first step. A board with a small crack can easily turn into a split board with enough precipitation and freezing. Depending on how the boards look, re-staining them to protect existing boards and replacing cracked ones



will ensure that you can go into spring strong. Examining the structural framing for mold, cracks or other damage is also a must because it could become a safety concern if left untouched.

Roof and Gutters: Inspecting the roof for missing, frayed or damaged shingles is the best first step. About 20% to 25% of your heat escapes through your roof, and loose or missing shingles can oftentimes exacerbate any issues through the winter if

one already exists. Accessing the attic and inspecting the roof for damp spots or mold from the inside will help indicate whether you have a leak to worry about.

Checking the gutters for wear and damage before the leaves start falling will help avoid a clog or leak from ruining your day in the future. If you have trees near your house, ensuring the gutters and roof are clear of debris and leaves before the snow starts falling will help prevent ice dams and rot.

Homestead Gardens:Rooted In The Community

umpkins and hay bales are in, humidity is on its way out, and the team at Homestead Gardens wants to get you set for next spring, now.

"Fall is the best time to establish your plants for next year," said Aimee Miskimon, general manager of Homestead Gardens in Severna Park. "We will continue to get fresh inventory so that our fall gardeners have everything that they need to have a good planting season and allow those plants to establish over the winter months so that in the spring

your garden is robust and beautiful."

Pointing to a hydrangea past its summer prime, Miskimon explained that now is actually the perfect time to put the beloved summer stunner in the ground. The slightly cooler temperatures and more frequent rain showers make for ideal conditions for the thirsty plant and less maintenance for the gardener. Though the plant may present as bare sticks in the dormant winter months, patience in the process will pay off next year.

Another advantage to fall planting is the ability to see the product in a more mature stage. Miskimon said it's common for customers to purchase young plants in the spring, and possibly not account for the amount of space they will take up as they grow. Waiting until fall allows for a more complete picture of what the selection will look like in a yard or garden, particularly when it comes to trees.

Homestead Gardens is offering local gardeners more than just planting materials this fall. The center is hosting a free educational series called "Garden Chores and Coffee" every Saturday in September and October, explaining in-depth the steps to take to ensure a

beautiful spring.

Hayley Bush, Homestead Gardens' marketing manager, explained that these types of events have traditionally been available at the flagship store in Davidsonville, and the staff is excited to begin offering them in Severna Park.

"Even though we're 25 minutes down the road, it is a different gardening journey here in Severna Park," Bush said, explaining that the high volume of oak trees in Severna Park creates a need for more shade-loving plants for the local clientele. "We're hoping it turns into this little garden community over a cup of coffee."

While the lectures and coffee are free, it is recommended to reserve a spot ahead of time.

Like well-established plants that require attention and care over time, so too do businesses. One way that Homestead Gardens has adapted to customers' requests is an expansion of Evelyn's Boutique, which features high-end women's apparel and accessories. This season, customers will find the boutique area doubled in size and selection.

Shoppers will also find pet care

items moved to the front of the store, highlighting the array of organic and high-quality pet food Homestead Gardens has to offer.

Sometimes, change is provoked by external forces. For Homestead Gardens, that came in the form of a new neighbor earlier this year. Rise Up Coffee Roasters, a popular Maryland coffee chain, opened in the adjoining business space formerly occupied by Zachary's Jewelers. With a door open between the two businesses, freshly caffeinated patrons can sip as they shop.

"It's really become a win-win kind of relationship for our community and for us," Miskimon said. "You can get yourself a cup of coffee and start at the front of the store and go to the back of the store and just check so many things off of your list."

What started decades ago as a family roadside produce stand is now a bustling three-store business, with roots firmly planted in the community – both literally, from the plants grown in the Davidsonville greenhouse, and figuratively, through partnerships with smaller businesses and commitment to various local

charities. Homestead Gardens' third and newest location is in Smyrna, Delaware.

The Severna Park store alone has donated hundreds of dormant perennials to the Friends of Anne Arundel County Trails, whose Master Gardeners plant them along the local trails for patrons to enjoy in spring and summer.

"They've remained so true to who they are as an organization," Miskimon said of the Riddle family, who founded Homestead Gardens in 1973.

When Miskimon began at Homestead Gardens roughly one year ago, she arrived early her first morning to walk the entirety of the store before it opened. The feeling she experienced as she roamed each aisle is one she aspires to share with her customers.

"I want them to come in and I want them to feel like this is their happy place," she said.

3. Outlets Not Working

Dead outlets can result from various issues, including faulty wiring or a broken outlet. If resetting a tripped breaker doesn't fix the problem, contact an electrician to diagnose and repair the issue.

When to Call an Electrician

What a name, right? Well, my mom had a saying, "You don't truly know someone until you've lived with them through all four seasons." The same holds true for a house, I've come to learn.

Our house is the opposite of an open floor plan. French doors close off each room on

By the heat of the summer, you can hear the white noise of seven window-mounted air conditioning units to keep all living zones comfortable. I

my kitchen cabinets mounted to the exterior wall. I felt spring and summer had the last laugh.

Into the fall months, I removed the window air conditioning units one by one. For a few weeks, we got by with opening our mostly original wood frame windows to let the fall air in during the day and close them at night. The whirring of the AC units was eventually replaced by the pinging of our cast iron radiators.

Rooms aren't heated evenly, so some bedroom doors stayed open; others shut. It was time to DIY heat shrink those same windows to keep the draft out and the heat in. The stained glass was cold to the touch. The exterior walls were chilly. We had to hang blankets on the walls at our beds to keep from touching the chilly wall in the middle of the night. No more melting chocolate at least!

Eventually, we saved enough to initiate our plan of attack. The house was long overdue for a siding upgrade. We paid to have the house wrapped and taped in an insulation board before the new siding was installed encapsulating and insulating the house from the outside.

The next year, we had the remaining original windows replaced with period-looking but high insulation value modern windows. We also had the stained glass covered with clear plexiglass inside and out, protecting it and adding a bit of insulation value.

Finally, we had two multizone mini split heating/cooling units installed, feeding all rooms of the house. This was a non-invasive way to upgrade to a heating/cooling system and still keep our radiator system intact as backup.

We donated the AC units, rehung the doors, took down the blankets, and don't even think about heat shrink and window tape, and most importantly, my chocolate doesn't melt in my cabinets in the summertime. We finally outsmarted the seasons in our 100-year-old home.

Most commonly, when you hear the term "oil-based sealer," it is referring to an asphalt cutback sealer used with mineral **gilsonite**, a naturally occurring form of bitumen that forms in regions of Northern Utah when petroleum solidifies. Compared to refined bitumen, it is extremely brittle and can be crushed into a dark brown powder. A telltale sign that a gilsonite-based sealer has been applied is an extremely shiny

and crystallized appearance.

Emulsions

Emulsions are a combination of bitumen, water and an emulsifying agent that helps with colloidal suspension.
Emulsions are macroscopically homogeneous and microscopically heterogenous. Sand and additives are agitated into asphalt emulsion sealers prior to application to enhance surface traction, drying and durability.

The Breakdown

Some people in the asphalt

industry will refer to asphalt emulsions as a "water-based" sealer to create a negative connotation around it. They will try to sell you by saying that their "oil-based" sealers are superior because they "penetrate the asphalt." In actuality, when applied to your driveway, the solvent in the material breaks down the existing binder in your asphalt pavement. Once the material is fully cured off, it leaves the asphalt worse

off than if nothing had been

applied in the first place.

On top of that, the brittle gilsonite has a higher softening point (200 or more degrees) than the natural binder in your asphalt. When applied, it will leave the surface of the pavement extremely brittle once dry. Comparatively, asphalt emulsions fill in the voids of the surface asphalt aggregate to form a protective film, creating a barrier from harmful environ-

mental elements.

Lastly, the released solvents from cutbacks are high in volatile organic compounds (VOCs), which have a negative impact on the environment. As asphalt emulsions cure and harden, harmless water is released into the environment.

As asphalt emulsions continue to improve, they remain the best option to seal and protect your asphalt pavement investment, not "penetrate" it. Don't be fooled by asphalt salesmen; do your research and ask prospective contractors the right questions on what product will be applied to your driveway.
